





## THE BRITISH SECTION

- 🇬🇧 A bilingual and bicultural education.
- 🇬🇧 Combines the traditional French curriculum with the British curriculum.
- 🇬🇧 In secondary school, high-level, Language-Literature and History-Geography classes added to all regular subjects from the French curriculum.
- 🇬🇧 **British** pedagogical approach to literature and history-geography.
- 🇬🇧 Distinctive education to children from English-speaking and bilingual family backgrounds, those who have learned English as a second or foreign language and who are committed to developing it at mother-tongue level.
- 🇬🇧 A challenging stream requiring academic ability and as well as motivation and commitment from students and families.
- 🇬🇧 Admission to British Section is subject to an admission test.



# THE BRITISH SECTION: AN OVERVIEW

The British section offers a bilingual education to children aged 6 to 18. Students spend between 1,5 hours and 6 hours per week, learning in English with British Section teachers. These hours are added to all regular subjects in French and students from the section follow the French curriculum in all subjects, in a primarily francophone educational environment. Entry levels are: from CP to 1ere.

- English Language and Literature from CP to CM2 (1,5h)

(\*added to the regular Language and EMILE classes)

### COLLEGE

- English Language and Literature from 6e to 3e (4h)  
(\*added to the regular Language classes)

- History-geography (2h in English + 2h hours in French)

- English language and literature (4h)  
(\*added to the regular Language classes)
- History-geography in English (2h + 2h hours in French).
